the dissemination of such a doctrine than might be found in industrial and mammfacturing centers of population.

In connection with the foregoing, an editorial published in LA NUEVA PRENSA of February 15, 1931, has been very favorably commented upon. A translation of the closing paragraph of this editorial reads as follows:-

"Public epinion demands aid for the unemployed,
see "Salving them something to do, but at the same time
requires that punitive measures be taken against
those who, under the closk of economic difficulties,
preach descration and counsel attacks on property
and persons. Costa Rice is for werkingmen, but it
is not a refuge for international highwaymen."
